- Ascension and Cliff Small Funeral Directors Charges are payable by the Client without any right of set off within 30 (thirty) days after receipt of Ascension & Cliff Small Funeral Directors invoice. We offer a finance facility where a Client is able to apply for finance to be used to pay for part or all of a funeral. This Facility is offered by Funeral Safe and repayments are made to Funeral Safe on a regular basis in accordance with terms agreed. Interest will be payable on such repayments.
